**All students participate in Hot Lunch, which is provided on Mondays and Fridays. We offer a locally sourced meal and always include a vegetarian option. We also include an extensive salad bar from the Crane certified organic gardens, fresh fruit, and a bagel and cream cheese station. (Parents are responsible for providing lunch for their child on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Lunch delivery options are available through a third party provider.)**

### Tuition Payment Options:

- 1) Single Payment Due May 15. (Tuition Protection Plan is optional)
- 2) Quarterly Payments Due May 15, July 15, October 15, and January 15 (Tuition Protection Plan is required and finance charges apply)
- 3) Ten monthly payments. 25% of balance due May 15. Remaining payments start July 15 and end April 15 (Tuition Protection Plan is required and finance charges apply)

### Optional Fees:

After-care: \$10/hour (Monday thru Friday, 3–5pm)

After School Enrichment Program classes: Costs and schedules vary

As an independent school, Crane Country Day School is autonomous with both our finances and governance. Since we receive no state or local monies, we stand on our own and primarily depend on tuition dollars. However, tuition does not cover the whole cost of a Crane education. We consciously limit tuition increases so that we can attract and retain a diverse and vibrant student community as well as remain comparable to other schools' tuition levels. For more than 85 years, Crane Country Day School has relied on the generosity of our extended community – parents, staff, trustees, grandparents, alumni and past parents – for both financial and volunteer support.

We purposefully have just three fundraising efforts we ask for your participation in each year: the Crane Country Fair, the Annual Fund, and the Spring Benefit.
